Science 8 Jumpstart is a week-long Science 7/8 transition program. Science 10 Jumpstart is also a week-long preview course for students who passed Science 9 and want to get an advanced look at Science 10 for the upcoming school year.

Both preview programs are for students attending S.T.A. in September 2017. Both preview programs are taught by Mr. Lamasan who teaches both courses during the school year.

Science 8 Jumpstart will consist of a review of key Science 7 concepts and provide students with a preview of the essential skills for their first year in Science 8 at S.T.A. With the famous Science 8 Science Fair (worth 20% of their mark), students will be taught the Scientific Method as well as be given advanced one-on-one assistance in selecting their topics which they can use for the upcoming year. Basic skills will be reinforced, tons of activities, and new lab skills will also be covered during this week as labs are a large component of the Science 8 program. Furthermore, students will be provided with a glance of different topics covered during the school year (Cells, The Kinetic Molecular Theory, Energy, and The Theory of Plate Tectonics).

Science 10 Jumpstart will preview key concepts covered in Science 10 at S.T.A. and provide a future look on the four major streams of Sciences (Chemistry, Biology, Physics, and Earth Sciences) available for Grade 11 courses. An overview of basic skills and lab work will also be covered. Furthermore, demos, activities, and practice reviews will be given daily to give students the edge of having an increased success rate for the upcoming Science 10 year!
