JUNE 2026 FINAL EXAM STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

When: Exams will be held from Monday, June 8, to Tuesday, June 16, 2026.

Classes will not be in session on these days. If you do not have an exam, you do not need to be in school. The Commons and Library areas will be open for QUIET STUDY. There will be no food service. **All students who come to school, whether to study or take an exam, MUST BE IN FULL UNIFORM. No exceptions.**

Where: Most exams will be written in the gym, with government literacy/numeracy exams written in the computer labs.

Arrival: Students should arrive for morning exams no later than 08:25 am. Students should arrive no later than 12:25pm for afternoon exams. Students will be called to line up outside the gym where attendance will be taken and then students will be directed into the exam room. Students who are writing in the LRC are also required to report for attendance outside the gym.

- Upon arrival at school, place *all belongings* in your locker including your cell phone which is to be turned off. Our no-cell phone policy and backpack policy will still be in place. Ensure you are in full uniform: proper shoes and socks, etc. Sweaters are optional.
- If you have been assigned textbooks, novels, or other course materials that have to be returned to your teacher, please be prepared to do so prior to your exam.
- Students arriving at school for oral presentations, interviews and numeracy/literacy provincial exams are to be in full school uniform.
- Once you enter the exam room, SILENCE is expected. Once you leave, you are expected to leave the school QUIETLY so as not to disturb exams still in progress.

What To Bring:

You may bring the following items with you to the exam room:

- ✓ Writing tools in a clear plastic bag
- ✓ Calculator (open for inspection)
- ✓ Water only in a closed container

DO NOT bring any of the following:

- X Cell phones or smart watches (will result in a zero)
- X Any notes or papers (exception of study sheets approved by the teacher)
- X Any other beverages, food or gum

Responsibilities of the Student:

- Maintain silence in the foyer and the gym.
- Do not attempt to communicate with any person during an exam.
- Do not cast suspicion on yourself during an exam.
- Students seen with a cell phone in an exam room will be sent out and may receive a zero for the exam being written.
- Any breach of these responsibilities could result in a zero for the exam you are writing.
- Exam, answer sheets, scantron forms, etc. submitted according to the directions given.

Duration: All school exams are up to **three** hours in length. For the government's Literacy and Numeracy Assessment, students are provided with up to three hours in which to complete the exam.

Exam Conflicts and Missed Exams: You are responsible for resolving any exam conflicts you might have. See Mr. Salituro to reschedule.

If a student is unable to attend due to illness, the office must be informed ahead of time and families must provide a medical note. Any and all exams to be rescheduled must be approved by Mr. Salituro.
