Qualifiers competed in last weekend's BCSS Provincial Championship Swim Meet, where there were 82 teams from across the province. Ryan L. and Owen H. each set personal best times in both Preliminaries and Finals. Owen's top finish was 4th place in 50m Back Multi-Class Para, dropping his time by an incredible 24 seconds, and narrowly



missing the podium. He finished 6th in 50m Free Multi-Class Para. Ryan's top finish was 5th place in both 50m Free and 50m Back Multi-Class Para. Their swims resulted in STA's highest Men's Team Score in recent history, with a 7th place finish out of all 'AA' schools, and 27th overall! Congratulations, swimmers!


