The Chapel

Many parents have never seen the school's chapel. The chapel is located on the main floor in the school's convent wing and was originally the chapel for the Sisters of the Child Jesus from 1932 to 2000. Featured on the walls are beautiful icons which have been purchased over the last eight years. These icons have been written (painted) by Andre Prevost, a noted iconographer. Andre, a former STA teacher, is the artist responsible for the paintings in St. Edmund's Church. The chapel icons have been made possible over the years by grants from the Parent Gaming Committee, the Parent Association, Campus Ministry, the STA Giving and Gratitude Annual Fund, the STA Religion Department, and various grad classes. In the coming months, each of the chapel icons will be featured in the STA At-a-Glance

Newsletter. The first icon to be displayed is of St. Juan Diego, who Our Lady of Guadalupe appeared to in 1531. He is the patron saint of all Indigenous peoples in the Americas, and his feast day is December 9.

On **Thursday**, **December 12** we are celebrating the **Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe**! The cafeteria will be serving Mexican inspired dishes and each student will receive a prayer card to celebrate this feast day!
