Classes will resume on Tuesday, February 18: Day 1 Chapel schedule.


Grade 12 Purdys Chocolates Easter Fundraising Campaign - now and until March 13

STA Chapel Icons #8 of 12 -Saint Kateri Tekakwitha (1656-1680)

St. Kateri Tekakwitha is the first Native North American to be recognized as a saint by the Catholic Church. Her mother was an Algonquin and her father was a Mohawk Chief. She contracted small pox as a child, which scarred her skin, so much so, that she would often hide her scars on her face with a blanket. When she was 19, she converted to Catholicism which alienated her from her family. Kateri was very devout and was known for her steadfast devotion. Her name, Kateri, is the Mohawk form of Catherine, which she took from Catherine of Siena. She was canonized on 21 October 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI. St. Kateri is the patroness of ecology and the environment, people in exile and Native Americans.
