Royal Canadian Legion Remembrance Day Contest Results

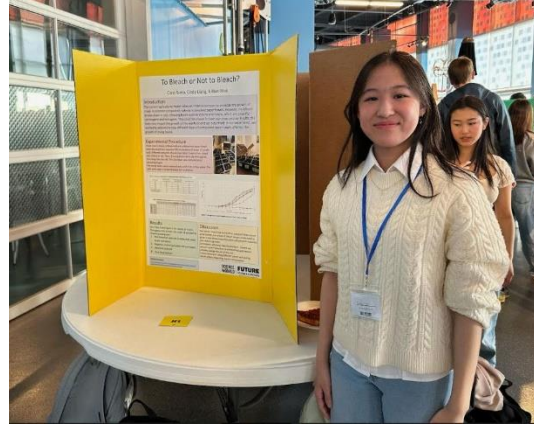
An impressive 101 entries were submitted by STA students last November and school winners were announced at an assembly on April 25.
